Day 1 - London To Amsterdam

Make your way to London St Pancras or Ebbsfleet and check in for the new direct Eurostar service to Amsterdam. Your journey will take you under the English Channel, through Brussels and Rotterdam, arriving into Amsterdam in just under 4 hours. On arrival, head for the Max Brown Hotel Canal District (or similar) and check in for a 2-night stay.



Day 2 - Amsterdam

Amsterdam is one of Western Europe's top travel destinations, with a beautiful cityscape made up of Golden Age canals, gabled houses, narrow streets and picturesque squares. Not to be missed attractions include the Van Gogh Museum, Anne Frank's House and the Rijksmuseum. ? TMR RECOMMENDS: Do as the locals do and hire a bike to explore the city! There are numerous places which offer bike hire near the station, or we can book bike tours either around the city or the surrounding countryside. Please ask for details.



Day 3 - Amsterdam To Delft

It's just an hour's journey from Amsterdam to Delft and your ticket will be 'open' which means that you can travel whenever you like. ?Once you arrive in Delft, check in for 2 nights at the BW Museumhotels Delft (or similar). Once you've settled in at your hotel, it's time to head out to begin your exploration of this quintessentially Dutch town.



Day 4 - Delft

Delft is famous around the world thanks to its connection with Dutch artist Johannes Vermeer and the distinctive Delft Blue earthenware, which you can buy all over the city. Don't miss a visit to the Vermeer Centre to learn about 'Dutch Light' and see the studio where some of the artist's most famous works were painted. You can also visit the factory where Delft pottery is made or learn more about the history of Holland at the Museum Prinsenhof. The best views in town can be had from the top of the Nieuwe Kerk tower.



Day 5 - Delft To London

After a leisurely breakfast in your hotel, head back to the station and catch a train to Rotterdam. After an easy change here, you'll be on the direct Eurostar back to the UK.
