Day 1 - Arrive In Bangkok

Bangkok is 7 hours ahead of GMT. On arrival, you will have a private transfer waiting to take you to the Amari Watergate Bangkok (or similar), where you will be staying for 2 nights. Settle in at your hotel before beginning your exploration of this lively and fascinating capital city. Alternatively, you may prefer to wind down from your journey with a relaxing spa treatment or a swim in one of the hotel's inviting pools.



Day 2 - Bangkok

Thailand's historic capital city is a huge, intoxicating metropolis, famous for its vibrant street life and ornate shrines. Sights not to be missed include the Royal Palace District, encompassing the Grand Palace and the Emerald Buddha Temple (Wat Pra Kaew), the city's colourful and chaotic Chinatown and the Damnoen Saduak floating market. You can also see the gigantic golden Reclining Buddha at Wat Pho and enjoy a traditional Thai massage at the end of a busy day of sightseeing.



Day 3 - Board The Eastern & Oriental Express

It's time to leave Bangkok today and begin your luxurious journey aboard the Eastern & Oriental Express, bound for Singapore. Once you have been checked in, settle into your private cabin as the train rolls out of Bangkok City and into Thai countryside. Dinner will be served in one of the train's opulent dining cars. Afterwards, why not head to the Bar Car to relax with fellow travellers before retiring to your cabin, which will have been transformed into an inviting bedroom.



Day 4 - The Bridge On The River Kwai

After breakfast onboard the train, you will disembark at the River Kwai Bridge station for a fascinating cruise along the river, guided by a local historian. On your return to the dock, you will be taken to visit to a war museum, chronicling the infamous construction of the Thai-Burma Railway. You can also choose to visit a local war cemetery. Return to the train in anticipation of a delicious lunch and dinner onboard.



Day 5 - Travel Through Malaysia

Spend a leisurely morning watching the changing scenery with breakfast in bed as the Eastern & Oriental Express travels on through Malaysia. Later in the morning, arrive at Kuala Kangsar. Disembark for a tour of the grand Ubudiah Mosque, the Royal Museum of Perak, housed in the beautiful Istana Kenangan (Remembrance Palace) and the Sultan Shah Gallery. Back aboard the train, enjoy a refreshing cocktail accompanied by live piano music before settling down for a sumptuous final dinner on board.



Day 6 - Arrival In Singapore

Enjoy breakfast in your cabin at a time to suit you before you arrive in Singapore at around 10.30. A transfer will be waiting to take you to the Vagabond Hotel (or similar) for a 2-night stay. Head out to explore this city and sovereign state in the afternoon, or choose to simply relax and unwind in your hotel, making use of some of the luxurious facilities on offer.



Day 7 - Singapore

Enjoy a full day at leisure in Singapore. This diverse city has many distinct, fascinating districts to explore. Whether you want to wander barefoot around a Hindu temple in Little India, top up your tan at one of the East Coast beaches or shop until you drop on Orchard Road, there's something for everyone here. After a long day of exploration, why not enjoy some authentic Malay food in Kampong Glam or swim in one of the city's huge outdoor, palm fringed swimming pools.



Day 8 - Depart Singapore

Your holiday comes to an end today as you check out of your hotel and leave Singapore. A transfer will take you to the airport for your overnight flight back to London (not included).
