## - Suggested Itinerary -



### Day 1 - London To Dijon

Catch a train to Paris and then connect onto a TGV service that will take you speeding through eastern France to Dijon. On arrival, check in for an overnight stay at the Oceania le Jura Hotel (or similar), conveniently located within walking distance of the station. Dijon is the capital of Burgundy, so it's not surprising that you can expect a delicious evening meal here, washed down with a glass of wine from a local vineyard.



### Day 2 - Dijon To Lake Maggiore

Return to the station this morning and travel across the Swiss border to Lausanne and then through the Simplon Tunnel into Italy. Before too long, you will arrive into the lakeside resort of Stresa, on the shores of Lake Maggiore. Make your way to the Regina Palace Hotel (or similar), where you will check in for a 4-night stay. TMR RECOMMENDS: Break your journey down to Stresa with a night in Switzerland. Lausanne and Montreux are both located on Lake Geneva and lovely locations for an overnight stop.



### Days 3, 4 & 5 - Lake Maggiore

Lake Maggiore is the second largest of Italy's famous lakes and offers stunning resorts, villas and gardens in a mountain-fringed setting. There are regular ferry services that will take you around, or you can simply relax and take in the scenery from a lake front gelateria. During your stay, don't miss a ride on the Mottarone cable car (which you can take from the Lido) for beautiful views over the lake. At the midway stop you can stroll around the Alpine gardens and look out over the three beautiful Borromean Islands of Bella, Madre and dei Pescatori below.



### Day 6 - Stresa To Strasbourg

Leave Lake Maggiore today and take a train to Basel on the border between Switzerland and France. An easy connection here takes you to Strasbourg, where you will stop for the night at the Hotel Hannong (or similar). Spend an evening exploring the cobbled streets of the Petite France district and enjoying some Alsatian food and wine in this stunning city.



### Day 7 - Strasbourg To London

Enjoy a leisurely start today before making your way back to the station for your return journey to London via Lille or Paris.
